Dear Guests

The River Club has taken the possibility of Day Zero very seriously and have set up a contingency plan to ensure it is business as usual for the River Club guests

We have implemented several water saving initiatives including:

- Hand sanitizers supplied for hand washing in all public bathrooms
- Where taps have not been disconnected, water saving nozzles (Aerators) have been installed. (These mist spray nozzles reduces water flow to 1 litre per minute (previous standard: 6 litres per minute)
- Table clothes and chair covers are being re-used
- The water pressure to bathroom taps has been lowered.
- Certain large-scale cleaning work has been paused including, deck cleaning etc
- High pressure hosing of areas (Rubbish areas) and watering of plants etc. has been stopped.
- All window washing in the building has been stopped

We continue to provide our guests with a hygienically clean building, allowing you to conference with us and have working toilets, a clean venue and good hygienic food.

We have drawn up a contingency plan for the potential Day ZERO

1. We will supply holding tanks on site for water to be stored in
2. Non-potable water will be trucked in when needed.
3. The water in the tanks will be pumped into the main council lines or we will use a bucket system to flush the toilets – Water is non- drinkable, but all toilets will work and be clean
4. The catering team will purchase potable water for cooking and cleaning. If required catering will use paper plates and paper napkins
5. Only bottled water to be used – Bottles to be recyclable
6. Paper coffee cups to be used – Recyclable
7. Waterless Toilet disinfectants to be used to keep toilets fresh
8. Catering to adjust menus for waterless cooking food offerings

Please be assured that we are working consciously with the water crisis to ensure ongoing smooth operations. It is going to be a team effort and together we are dedicated to keeping it BUSINESS AS USUAL

We would like to thank you for all your support in our water saving endeavours.
